

# ATHE Level 5 Extended Diploma in Management

## Qualification Overview

The ATHE Level 5 Extended Diploma in Management is a 120 credit Ofqual regulated qualification and is the equivalent level to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of a Bachelor's degree. This qualification has been designed for learners who are seeking to progress to take the final year of a Bachelor's degree course in an area of management.

This qualification aims to develop learners understanding of management and to develop key management skills.
